



KEYSTONE LAKE

## CERTIFICATE

1, Brett King, the undersigned, a Registered Professional Land Surveyor L.S. 1533, in the State of Oklahoma, of Landmark Surveying, C.A. 4572 6-30-07, of 520 South Mill, P.O. Box 1328, Pryor, Oklahoma (918-825-2804) do hereby certify that a careful survey of the following described property was made under my supervision:
